Arrived on scene approximately 6:20 p.m.

Assisted in controlling scene and taking names and addresses of persons on the scene.

At 7:15 Sheriff sent me to Mrs. Neese's home (suspect's Grandmother) for suspect's clothes. Accompanied by Mr. Louis Davis (suspect's Uncle).

Mrs. Neese handed me the clothes on front step. I asked her for a bag to put them in and was invited into house. Put clothes in sack and departed. Returned to Alford's Store.

8:15 transported suspect to county jail. Judge Teel said book for material witness.

9:00 turned clothes over to Lieutenant T. E. Gosdin.
