

Indictment

INDICTMENT: State of Alabama, Coosa County, Circuit Court, Spring Term, 1979, Grand Jury Docket No. 24. Grand Jury of said County charged that before the finding of this indictment, Timothy Charles Davis, whose true name to the Grand Jury, is unknown, otherwise than as stated, did feloniously take one leather billfold, brown in color, being of the approximate value of, to-wit: Twelve dollars, the personal property of Avis F. Alford, from her person and against her will, by violence to her person, or by putting her in such fear by unwilling to part with the same and during the course of said robbery, did intentionally kill Avis F. Alford, by stabbing her with a knife, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama. And it is signed by William Hill, who is the District Attorney of this Eighteenth Judicial Circuit.
