I worked Thursday, July 20, 1978 until 3:00 p.m. at Willow Point Country Club along with my Father. When we got off at 3:00 my Father drove us to Russell Mills in Alexander City where my Mother works. Mother got off at 4:00 p.m. and we went home.

When I got home I stayed for a few minutes then went down to my friend's house (Timothy Davis), and told him I was going to walk to the store (Brant's Grocery). Tim said I could use his motorcycle. I rode to Brant's Grocery and bought 74¢ worth of gas. I then went to my friend's house for a while and when I left I took Tim's motorcycle back home.

When I got back Tim took me home and left on his motorcycle going toward Fish Pond Road (Alabama 259).

When I got home I stayed outside and played ball for a while then went in and watched To Tell The Truth on Channel 6.
