On July 20, 1978 on a Thursday afternoon, I Linnie Neighbors was at home next door to Alford's Grocery. Most everyday I go down to Alford's Grocery to visit Mrs. Avis Alford. I left the house at approximately 3:30 p.m. I got to the store and started in the store when Mrs. Alford told me to just sit on the front porch, that she was coming out there to sit. So I did. She came out and we just sit and talked. I guess we talked for an hour. She was in a good mood, except she complained of one of her feet bothering her. Anyway, I stayed there till about 4:40 or 4:45 p.m. While I was there nobody had come in the store. I left the store went up to my house, went in and locked all my doors and went across the road to my son's house. His name is Gerald Neighbors. The reason I left when I did is because we eat supper at 5:00 p.m. I heard a motorcycle, but I don't know if it was when I first got to my son's or after I'd been there awhile. I did not see a motorcycle. Mr. Harris, the man running for Road Commissioner stopped in for a few minutes, gave us a card and left. Then about 5:30 p.m. Mrs. Allen Spivey came over and told us what had happened. Then we all went to the store and watched.
