On July 20, 1978 on a Thursday afternoon at 5:05 p.m. I passed by Alford Grocery on Fish Pond Road or Highway 259. I just got off of work and was headed home. I live in Equality, Alabama. Anyway I tipped the hill above Alford's Grocery at 5:05 p.m. and saw a young White male on a motorcycle turning into Alford's Grocery. I think the motorcycle was gold. I also think the helmet is gold. Anyway, he was still on his motorcycle. I didn't see him get off the cycle. He also had light brown hair hanging about two inches below his helmet out the back. I guess the reason I noticed the hair is because I don't especially like long hair. Also he had on dark colored blue jeans and I think he had on a T-shirt. I don't remember anything else about the motorcycle. A little later my wife, Nancy, and my kids left home to go to the Sonic in Alexander City to eat. As we went by Alford's Grocery, we noticed all the law there, but I thought it was a wreck or something. Anyway when we were headed back home from Alex City the law was still there. I stopped and asked what happened. They told me someone had been murdered. that's when I remembered this boy on a motorcycle and thought I'd tell someone about it. I hope this will help to find out who done this.
