In May, 1978, I purchased a 1975 Honda 175, gold and white in color from Ray Davis, Route 2, Box 347, Dadeville, Alabama, for \$300.00.

I sold the motorcycle to Tim Davis for \$250.00, sometimes during the week of July 10, 1978. Tim Davis worked in the Distribution Center at Russell Mills where I am employed. Tim Davis did not pay me any money at that time, but was going to pay me a sum of approximately \$100.00 when his Grandmother came back. Tim Davis only paid me \$20.00 in cash instead of the \$100.00.

On Thursday, July 20, 1978 at approximately 9:00 a.m. during the first break at the Distribution Center while at work, I talked with Tim Davis and told Tim Davis that I was going to get married on Friday and needed for him (Tim Davis) to bring me some of the money for the motorcycle before 12 noon, because I was going to be off at 12 noon. I did not tell him any amount. Tim Davis did not indicate the amount of money he (Tim Davis) was going to pay.

I remember that before selling the motorcycle that the right front hand brake lever was broken. The gear shift and back brake pedal was bent. When I purchased the motorcycle from Ray Davis, there was a tag already on the motorcycle.
